## Pre-Event Information

### Dates and venues

Finals: 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> April 2018 (Strathclyde Country Park/Glasgow University Sailing Club)

### Affiliation & insurance information

All institutions participating in BUSA/BUCS events are required to be members of BUSA.

It is the responsibility of either the individual or institution to ensure that all entrants have appropriate insurance in order to compete. BUSA and BUCS DO NOT insure any competitor for any of their events.

### Registration and Briefing

Teams who arrive early may register between 1930 and 2100 on the evening of Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> April in the Lansdowne Bar & Kitchen, 7a Lansdowne Crescent, G20 6NQ. Registration will continue on Monday the 2<sup>nd</sup> between 0830 and 0900 at the marquee on the loch side of Strathclyde Loch, Strathclyde Country Park, Motherwell, ML1 3ED.

All competitors must attend registration and produce their university registration / matriculation cards to prove their student status. NUS cards WILL NOT be accepted as proof of eligibility to compete.

The Competitors' Briefing will take place at 0915 in The Lochside Marquee on Monday the 2<sup>nd</sup>.

### Location Information

Parking is permitted in the main car park of the Watersports Centre. To get to The Lochside Marquee, either make your way around the Centre or through it, and then head left along the waterfront past the bridge to the Race Office Tower. Changing rooms can be found in the Watersports Centre, up the stairs and along to the left. Lockers are available in the changing rooms.

### Event Schedules and Results

The Draw for the first round of the Swiss League will be made on Sunday the 1<sup>st</sup>. The Schedule of races will be published online through [KSail](#). Race Results will be updated live online throughout the event.

### Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be posted online prior to the event and on the Official Notice Board on Monday the 2<sup>nd</sup> onwards. Team captains will also receive a copy at registration.

**Competitors are reminded that, as well as Buoyancy Aids, Wetsuits or Drysuits will be required.**

### Damage

Sailing is a non-contact sport where damage to people, boats and equipment is generally avoidable. Teams notice is drawn to Appendix 2 of the [Notice of Race](#) which explains the system for charging for any damage to boats and equipment.
