# Bristol Brew Notice of Race University of Bristol Sailing Club 3th- 4th December 2016

### 1. Introduction

The event is for three boat teams and will be sailed in Fireflies supplied by the University of Bristol Sailing Club and other universities. Each boat shall be sailed by two people.

# 2. Organising Authority

The organising authority is the University of Bristol Sailing Club.

### 3. Rules

- 3.1. The event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing including appendix D, Team Racing Rules.
- 3.2. The races will be umpired.
- 3.3. The UK Team Racing Association (UKTRA) Standard Team Racing Sailing Instructions will apply. These change some rules in the RRS; they are available on the UKTRA web site (www.teamracing.org) and at registration.
- 3.4. In accordance with rule 70.5(a) the right of appeal will be denied.

# 4. Entries and Deposit

- 4.1. Entries can be from registered universities and/or sailing clubs.
- 4.2. The closing date for receipt of entries is Monday 7th November 2016.
- 4.3. The entry fee will be £270 per team, if entry forms are sent in on or before Monday 24th October 2016. From this point to the  $7^{th}$  of November the fee will rise to £310.
- 4.4 The entry fee should be in cheque format, payable to University of Bristol Sailing Club. It should be posted to 29 Southleigh Road, Bristol, BS8 2BQ, with a note making clear who it is from. The cheque will need to be received before a team can be fully registered.
- 4.5 Social tickets will be available at £15pp.
- 4.6. If the team withdraws their entry 2 weeks or less before the event, we will retain your entry fee.
- 4.7. If a team provides fireflies for use at the Bristol Brew, their entry fee will be waivered.
- 4.8. Each team will be liable for the cost of damage to boats, equipment and property up to a maximum of £300 per incident. A deposit for this amount (also in cheque format) will be required at registration and before a team may sail. If the organising authority estimates that the total damage attributable to the team exceeds the deposit, the team will be required to deposit a further £200 in order to continue sailing. Damage attributed to competitors generally or to an unidentified team will be attributed equally between all teams. A team may apply to the protest committee to determine their responsibility for any damage.

### 5. Event Format and Schedule

- 5.1. The format for the event will be available at registration.
- 5.2. Registration will take place at Chew Valley Lake Sailing Club at 9am on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2016.
- 5.3. There will be a briefing at Chew Valley Lake Sailing Club at 9.30am on Saturday 3rd December 2016.
- 5.4. The first warning signal will be at 10.15am on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2016.

### 6. Buoyancy and Clothing

Adequate personal flotation devices and wet or dry suits shall be worn by all competitors at all times when afloat. This must include adequate footwear.

# 7. Disclaimer of Liability, Insurance

- 7.1. A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.
- 7.2. It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching or going to sea, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and that her crew is competent to sail and compete in them.
- 7.3. When the boats are provided by the competitors, the boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims as required by the notice of race or, if not specified, in the sum of at least the UK market norm (currently three million pounds).

- 7.4. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, umpires, patrol boats and beachmasters.
- 7.5. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibilities.

# 8. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.
