The team will be chosen by a panel of external selectors from sailors' performances throughout the year, at the upcoming BUSA team-racing and match-racing finals, and on the strength of their CVs. This competition truly is the pinnacle of British university sailing as one of the most prestigious university sailing competitions in the world, and a fantastic opportunity to represent your country and be part of an event which has run for over 50 years. I would encourage anyone to apply (boys and girls – the tour is an open competition) and so please spread the word around your university sailing clubs to make sure that everyone gets the opportunity to be selected. The deadline for applications is the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013.
