Simon thanked the 1999/2000 Committee for all their hard work. He also thanked Tessa Pelly, the BUSA/RYA secretary for putting in a lot of work towards the development of BUSA.

8. Matters for discussion

Championship format

Archie Massey raised the issue of having a Gold League at the BUSA Championships. Many options were discussed in view of this including the following:

- Seeding from mini-leagues completed on the 1st day.
- Gold, Silver and Bronze leagues, how would these be seeded, would the bronze league be able to win?

This was voted upon and there was no decisive answer. It was decided that the Committee would put together a working group to discuss and decide upon this.

Mark Campbell James asked whether it would be possible for the Universities that had reached the quarter finals the previous year to bypass the qualifier system and get an automatic place to the finals.

It was thought that teams were often very different from one year to the next and that for the general standard of University Team Racing it was better for the poorer teams to race against the stronger teams.

Cost of Events

It was agreed by all present that BUSA should encourage all Universities to limit the entry fees for their events to £130. The running to the racing never cost more than this and socials and

lunches could be charged separately. If the University wished to charge non-University teams more than this they could do.
