What did we do? COMMUNICATE MORE

- Committee member bios & pictures Promoted on Facebook, Instagram and Website. All discipline specific posts are written by the Officers.
- Visibility of meeting minutes & actions Summary by BUSA Chair. Promoted on Facebook, Instagram, Area pages, Website Documents page.
- FB Page + Email = Must Know Information Use of the facebook group as a member forum and website/email/facebook page for BUSA communications.
- Working with Technical Delegates and BUCS As BUCS decide the "rules", we consult our specialist TDs and students for advice, ensuring transparency.



2. Committee Ethos




- Ease of communication throughout committee Chair and Administrator contactable via phone and email whenever needed to answer questions & discuss ideas.

 No big decisions were made regarding championship formats or gender rules without member opinions & insight.
- Skype sub-committee and committee meets To enable all committee members to be present, 50% of national meetings are now held via evening Skype calls.

Use of Facebook Group & Page Announcements, reports, BUCS events posted on PAGE. Club events, student posts, committee updates on GROUP.


Increased use of Instagram

Huge growth in Instagram posts and followers over the 2019/20 season. Control given to host clubs during events.

- Website-Documents page & online notice board Weekly docs page update (resources, minutes, opportunities). Intro of live notice board. A clear BUSA 'Brand' across docs.
- Introduction of Termly Email Newsletters Introduction of Mail Chimp email newsletters sent to the membership including reports, opportunities and changes.



4. Funding availability and support



What did we do? ADVISE & PUBLICISE

- Internal review of funding and budget Clear dividing of accounts to sustainably support all disciplines and member clubs, whilst maintaining quality.
- Wider development fund call

2 funding windows opened to all member clubs, support of 6 development areas and projects in all regions supported.

Funding advice circulated to membership BUSA specific resources added to website docs page. All clubs contacted by area chairs to personify support.

Membership survey conducted

Annual figures (boats/members/development plan) collected for each club to improve BUSAs understanding.



5. Equal Opportunities



What did we do? SUPPORT & CONNECT

- Support through BUSA Development Fund 5 female sailing projects were supported including the first keelboat helming weekend with the Majenta Project.
- Inclusion of accessible sailing in major events 2 Hansa sailors entered BUCS Fleet Champs, now sailing weekly with their clubs. Further collaborations coming!

Social Sailing Support

BUSA have encouraged and supported clubs to welcome beginners by creating resources, case studies & events.

Improved relationship between SSS & BUSA All SSS events, projects & courses are promoted and reported. Three SSS members sit on the BUSA Committee.



6. Club Support



What did we do? RESEARCH & ADVISE

- Collection of club specific goals and struggles 2019 member club goals/barriers given to area chairs to ensure region specific support from a student offered.
- Guide to writing your development plan Detailed resources created by the BUSA Development Officer and edited by committee to ensure accessibility.
- Coach and instructor training courses
 BUSA Development Funded projects ran in Scotland and
 Midlands to support development of clubs at all levels.
- New partnerships and RYA signposting Partnership forged with Andrew Simpson Foundation Trust. Signposting to conferences, webinars & training resources.



7. Quality of competition



What did we do? DISCUSS & EXPAND

- Bidding Opportunities extended to UK SCs To increase BUSAs hosting partnerships & increase competition for BUCS events, all sailing clubs can now bid.
- Further Opportunities Website page Launch of the regularly updated page with paid/unpaid opportunities, international events, crewing spaces & more.
- International opportunities for more members The BUSA and ICSA Chairs and Coach skyped to discuss barriers, changes and ways to improve what 'Tour' offers.
- Learning from consultations- location location! The fleet and match racing consultations highlighted the value of a central location, now a key selection criterion.
