Notice #6: Southern Qualifiers Reserve Weekend - Requirement for non-racing volunteer

The BUCS Team Racing Championship Southern Qualifiers Reserve Day will take place on Sunday 16 February 2020 at Farmoor Reservoir. BUSA and the local organisers have been struggling to source sufficient volunteers to run the event to a high standard.

Due to the lack of available volunteers, we will require each competing team to provide a non-racing volunteer as described in the Notice of Race (NoR).

Pursuant to NoR 11.1, each team competing in the Southern Qualifiers Reserve Day is required to bring **one** non-racing volunteer.

This volunteer must be prepared to assist with the running of the event (e.g. start boat / finish boat) and be prepared to go afloat during the event. This volunteer need not be registered on BUCSPlay but their identity should be declared to the BUSA Secretary.

The BUSA Secretary can be contacted via email at busasec@gmail.com. Please provide the name, email address and mobile number of the nominated volunteer. This information must be provided by Tuesday 11 February 2020. If the volunteer has a preferred role then please state this also. Roles will be issued on a first come, first served basis.

Teams which do not provide a non-racing volunteer will be subject to protest, with the Race Committee requesting a substantial penalty from the Protest Committee.

We regret that this is once again necessary, however, it is needed to provide an event of a suitable quality for the competition. We thank all teams in advance for their understanding. The Technical Delegates would also like to place on record their thanks for all volunteers that attended the Southern Qualifiers weekend on 1 and 2 February 2020 - their assistance was very much appreciated.
